

## I. Basic approach

- 1. There is a strong urge for **agreement on a fair and effective international framework with the participation of all major emitters that is compatible with economic growth** at COP21 to be held in Paris at the end of the year.
- 2. As efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions intensely affect economic activity and national life, and require the implementation of measures that entail public burden, countries have maintained an unyielding stance at the negotiation table. The Japanese government should contribute to international negotiations in a way that will enable all countries to reach agreement at COP21 while also pursuing national interests.
